AS USED IN THE BIBLE, “SINS” REFERS TO THE INDIVIDUAL ACTS OF SIN THAT THE BODY COMMITS; WHEREAS “SIN” MEANS THE PROPENSITY TO SIN ITSELF KNOWN AS “SINFUL NATURE” OR WHAT IS CALLED THE “OLD MAN”

Note: This is based on the revelation that we are spirit, soul, & body and that only the spirit may be born again.

January 05

- (a) When we got born again, the old man* died; JESUS put sin away from us*;
- (b) The strength of sin is the law;* hence, sin may no longer touch believers;
- (c) Religious traditions make the word of God of none effect*, teaching unbelief.

January 12

- (a) God chose us in him before the foundation of the world so as to be holy &
- (b) Without blame before Him in love having predestinated us unto adoption
- (c) Of children by Jesus Christ to himself according to the pleasure of his will.*

January 19

- (a) Many Christians do not know that Jesus died for all sins to free humanity*;
- (b) Not automatically, but as many as may believe and accept Jesus as savior*;
- (c) This must be seen as a great provision of salvation, not as a license to sin.*

January 26

- (a) Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him:
- (b) He cannot sin, because he is born of God. He that commits sin is of the devil.*
- (c) This is why Jesus was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.*
